Topics and Themes

Exploring Inside and Out

This topic supports the children to feel comfortable in the classroom, getting to know the inside and outside space and the routines of the day. They will learn to play alongside others and with their teachers, sharing resources and learning to tidy up.

Brown Bear Brown Bear

Our first story will be Brown Bear, we will learn colours, animals and can make our own variations of this story. We will look at lots of different stories and songs with bears in. We will explore Non Fiction using this topic by learning about bears around the world, and what they look like and what they eat.

Myself and My Family

We will begin to explore our understanding of the world through talking about ourselves, what we like and drawing self portraits. Then we will share our families and look at the similarities and differences that make us and our families special.

Prime Areas of Learning

Communication and Language

Join in with rhymes and songs and actions

Play alongside an adult, listening to what the adult is saying.

Learn key words with Makaton sign language to help us with routines.

Physical Development

We love going outside to exercise our whole body through:

Driving scooters and bikes, pushing with our feet and working on our balance.

Climbing steps and stairs to help us build the co-ordination to use alternate feet.

Jumping from spot to spot and jumping down from a higher to a lower height.

Practising moving in different ways such as running, galloping, walking etc.

We will practice rolling, kicking and chasing a ball.

Inside we exercise our bodies daily with funky fingers exercises to help us build strong fingers for writing. We will be having fun with Dough Disco, Squiggle While You Wiggle and Wake up Shake ups.

We will become more and more independent when going to the toilet and washing our hands. Building our confidence to ask for help when we need it.
